
Vad är spamassassin/Spam filters?

Adjust Spam Threshold Score


Configure the Spam Score Threshold. If your hosting provider enables rewrites, the server will add a Spam Threshold Score.

Spam Threshold Score (required_score) ?

Spam messages score higher calculated spam scores than regular messages. If a message's calculated spam score meets or exceeds the Spam Threshold Score, the system will label that message as spam. For example, an account that uses a Spam Threshold Score of 10 will only mark messages that are obviously spam. A Spam Threshold Score of 2 will label many messages as spam, which includes messages that are likely **not** spam. We recommend that new users use the default setting of 5. We recommend that an [ISP](#) set this score to 8. The Spam Threshold Score does not affect the Auto-Delete Threshold Score.
